GEORGIA STATE USBC YOUTH COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must meet all eligibility requirements (a - e)

- a) **MUST** have been a youth member of USBC for at least (3) years and **MUST NOT** have reached your 20th birthday as of August 1 of the current bowling year.
- b) **MUST** be enrolled in an under graduate program, **Graduate work is not eligible.**
- c) **MUST** furnish a complete up to date college transcript of all grades.
- d) **MUST** have a GPA 2.5 or higher.
- e) **MUST** submit application, transcript, and recommendations together in one package and be **postmarked no later than deadline February 15th.**

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1. The Georgia State USBC Youth Association will award at least one scholarship to a college student who meets the eligibility requirements and receives the Highest Combined Point Total during the evaluation process.
 2. At least one (1) \$1000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a college student (boy or girl) but not necessarily every year.
 3. Additional scholarships may be awarded based on available funding.
 4. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of not less than (4) four members of the Georgia State USBC Youth Board, one of the five being an officer.
 5. The Scholarship committee will evaluate each applicant’s academic ability as indicated by transcript, hardship, and recommendations based on the information submitted. Individual(s) with Highest Combined Point Total will be the recipient(s) of the scholarship aid. The decision of the Scholarship committee is final.
 6. College Scholarship(s) awarded will be administrated by the Association Manager of the Georgia State USBC Youth Association. Funds will be available for use within (4) four years of selection. Recipients are required to furnish information requested and the Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the school within 30 days of the request. In the event the scholarship is not used, it will revert back to the Georgia State USBC Youth Association.
 7. All applications must be **mailed** to the Scholarship Chairperson. **(US Mail ONLY)**
 8. Scholarship Recipient(s) will be notified by mail / email. Scholarships will be presented at the Georgia State USBC Youth Annual Awards Luncheon/Dinner in July.
 9. **Application Transcript, Letter of Recommendations MUST be mailed together in one package and be postmarked no later than deadline February 15th - No exception**
 10. **Any Application received with a Postmark after February 15th will not be accepted.**
