GEORGIA STATE USBC YOUTH HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must meet all eligibility requirements (a - d)

- a) Eligibility is restricted to Certified USBC Members bowling in youth leagues under the jurisdiction of the Georgia State Association.
 - b) **Must** be a High School Junior or a High School Senior.
 - c) **Must** furnish a complete high school transcript of grades 9 – 12.
 - d) **Must** submit application, transcript, and recommendations together in one package and be postmarked no later than deadline February 15th.
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1. The Georgia State USBC Youth Association will award at least one (1) scholarship of \$1000.00 to a boy or girl who meets the eligibility requirements and receives the Highest Combined Point Total during the evaluation process.
 2. Additional scholarships may be awarded based on funds available from the Georgia State USBC BA, Georgia State USBC Women’s Assn. and the Georgia State Bowling Council.
 3. The number of scholarship(s) to be awarded shall be approval of the Georgia State USBC Youth Board of Directors. The amount(s) awarded shall be based on the current funding available and may not be the same every year.
 4. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of not less than (4) four members of the Georgia State USBC Youth Board, one of the four being an officer.
 5. The Scholarship committee will meet to evaluate each applicant’s academic ability as indicated by transcript, bowling participation, hardship, and recommendations based on the information submitted. Individuals with Highest Combined Point Total will be the recipients of the scholarship aid. The decision of the Scholarship committee is final.
 6. Scholarships awarded from following the State organizations: USBC Youth, USBC WBA, and Bowling Council will be administrated by the Association Manager of the State Youth Association. Scholarship funds will be available for use within (4) four years of selection. Recipients are required to furnish information requested and the Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the school within 14 days of the request.
 7. The State USBC BA awarded scholarships will be administrated by the Association Manager of the BA Association. Scholarship funds will be deposited in a SMART.
 8. Applications must be **mailed** to the Scholarship Chairperson. **(1st Class US Mail ONLY)**
 9. Scholarship Recipient(s) will be notified by mail. Scholarships will be presented at the Georgia State USBC Youth Awards Luncheon/Dinner in July.
 10. **Application, Transcript, Letters of Recommendations must be submitted together. Postmark Deadline February 15 – No exception.**
